



Fig. 1: Identifying Audio System Components Location Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.

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




Fig. 6: Identifying Audio Unit Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.




Fig. 7: Exploded View Of Audio Unit Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.






Fig. 9: Identifying Car-Navigation Unit Components & Torque Specifications Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.





Fig. 10: Identifying Audio Amplifier Components & Torque Specifications Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.




Fig. 12: Identifying Front Door Speaker Components Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.




Fig. 13: Identifying Front Door Module & Wiring Harness Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.

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




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Fig. 14: Identifying Front Door Speaker Terminals Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.




Fig. 16: Identifying Rear Door Module & Wiring Harness Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.






Fig. 18: Identifying Front Speaker Components Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.

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


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Fig. 21: Identifying Center Speaker Terminals Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.






Fig. 24: Identifying Roof Speaker Components Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.






Fig. 26: Identifying Tweeter Components Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.




Fig. 28: Identifying Tweeter Terminals Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.




Fig. 29: Identifying Speaker Outputs Sound Order Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.




Fig. 30: Identifying Bass-Box Components & Torque Specifications








Fig. 35: Identifying Noise Filter Terminals Continuity Chart Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.

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


Fig. 36: Identifying Noise Filter Terminals Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.



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
Fig. 38: Identifying Glass Antenna Terminals Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.








Fig. 44: GPS Antenna Feeder Terminals Continuity Chart Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.





Fig. 45: Identifying GPS Antenna Feeder Terminals Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.




Fig. 47: Identifying Audio Control Switch Components Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.








Fig. 51: Audio Control Switch Terminals Continuity Chart (With HF/TEL System) Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.




Fig. 52: Identifying Audio Control Switch Terminals (With HF/TEL System) Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.




Fig. 53: View Of Microphone Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.





Fig. 54: Identifying RES Unit Components & Torque Specifications Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.





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
Fig. 57: View Of Battery Case Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.





Fig. 59: Identifying Auxiliary Terminal Unit Screws Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.






Fig. 64: Identifying Hands-Free Telephone (HF/TEL) Unit Components & Torque Specifications Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.



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
Fig. 65: Identifying Accessory Socket & Cap (Front) Courtesy of MAZDA MOTORS CORP.





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

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


Fig. 71: View Of Auxiliary Jack
